This Bid Bulletin No. 1 is issued for the purpose of clarifying specific sections of the bidding documents.

1. Respondent Lists for Treatment Groups (200 migrants and 100 family members):

The vendor will *not* be required to independently identify or recruit respondents. All survey participants are part of the project and already included in the research sample. IOM will provide the respondent lists together with the necessary contact details. The role of the vendor is to **conduct the interviews in accordance with the questionnaire, field protocols, and data collection protocols *provided by IOM.***

2. Definition of the Control Group (100 respondents):

The control group is composed of migrants who have been exposed to some activities of the project intervention. The endline survey serves as part of the evaluation of these interventions. For the purpose of this consultancy, the vendor is not required to identify or differentiate between treatment and control groups during data collection. This distinction will be managed at the research and analysis stage by IOM.
